




THE LADY OF THE SKY

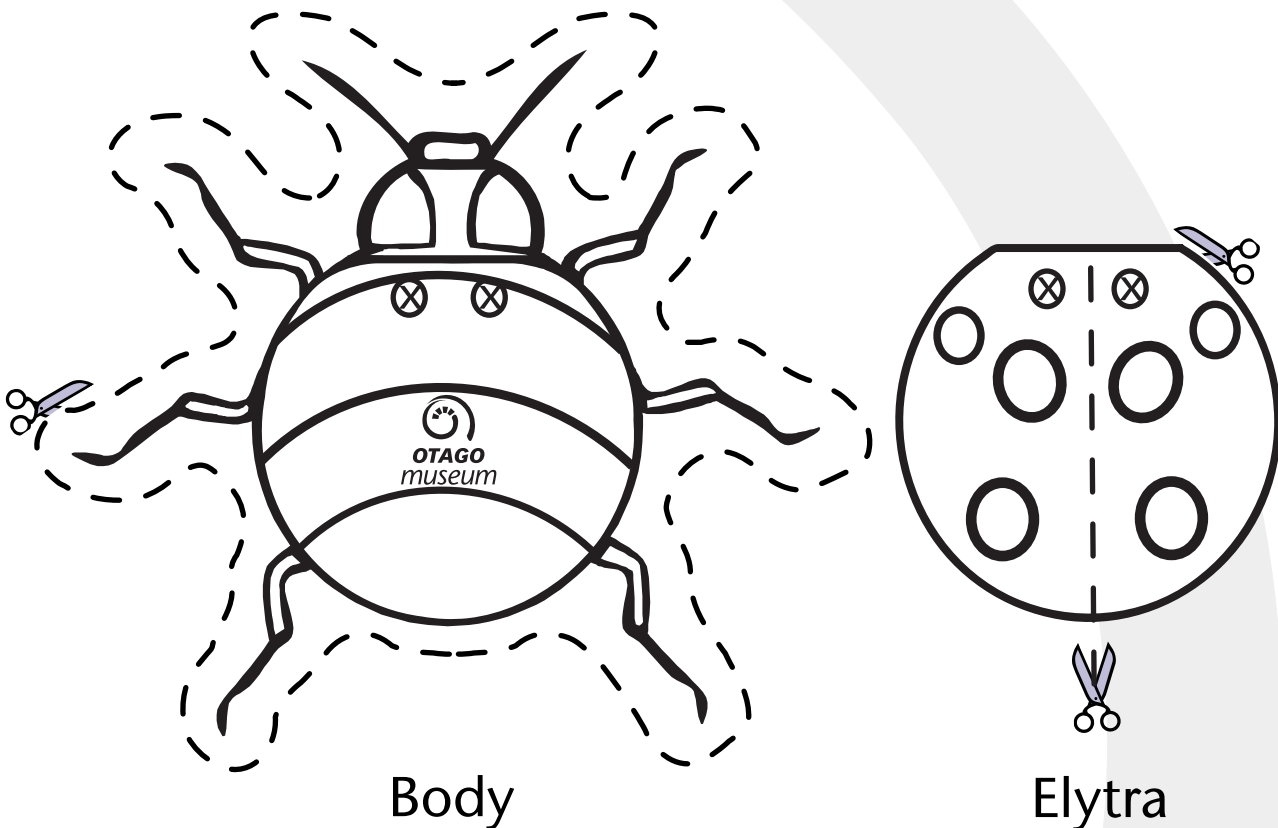
Make your very own ladybird who loves to fly!

Ladybirds have a pair of wings hiding under a hard wing cover called the elytra. When the ladybird is ready to fly the elytra spreads apart revealing magnificent wings ready for take off!

To create your ladybird, follow these simple instructions:

1. Colour and cut the body and elytra pieces below 
2. Using the elytra shape as a template cut out two cellophane wings for your ladybird
3. Punch holes in the X-marked circles on the body. Line up the elytra and the cellophane shapes and punch holes in the X-marked circles
4. Assemble your ladybird by putting a split pin in through the elytra, the wings and then the body folding the split pin flat at the back

Now your ladybird is ready to fly!
