There are two age categories:
Up to and including 14 years; 15 years and over

Photo categories are:

1. Plant; 2. Animal; 3. Human impact on the natural environment

This competition is for amateur photographers only

A maximum of four entries will be accepted per entrant. These entries can be across all the categories but are restricted to no more than two entries per photo category. The format for photographs is **unmounted prints, size 6" x 8"**. Please state the orientation of the image on the reverse of the photo. You must submit your photo/s to the Otago Museum by 5pm, Monday 19 March 2012.

An exhibition of the Otago Wildlife Photography Competition will be held at the Otago Museum, opening Thursday 5 April 2012. FREE!

All entries must be taken by an Otago resident no earlier than 1 January 2011. For the purpose of this competition, 'wildlife' is deemed to include domestic and non-domestic animals.

All entries must represent the natural world as authentically as possible, free of excessive digital manipulation, with honesty in all captioning, and total regard for the welfare of the animals and their environment.

For the purpose of this competition, you are considered professional, and therefore ineligible for entry, if you derive 20% or more of your annual income from photography. All fields on the entry form must be completed. All details as per entry form must also be written on or attached to the back of each entered photograph.

Images entered will not be returned.

Category finalists may be required on request to provide the original source of their photograph for enlargement and display purposes.

Submitted entries that fail to meet the specified format will not be considered.

Please indicate on the reverse of the submitted photograph which side is 'top'.

The competition sponsors reserve the right to exhibit, reproduce, and/or publish any image entered in the competition for publicity, promotional, publication and exhibition purposes relating to the photographic competition. Appropriate attribution will be given to the photographer. Entrants retain copyright of their images. Winners will be notified by mail and prizes presented at an official function on Wednesday 4 April 2012 at the Otago Museum. Staff and families of the competition organisers and sponsors are not eligible to enter the competition. Prizes are not transferable or redeemable for cash.

The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
